

PAYING FOR YOUR COURSE

We aim to make learning accessible for all. There are a variety of ways to pay as well as funding schemes from both the College and the government to help support you with your studies.

Funding your studies

Depending on your circumstances, you may be eligible for free or partially funded courses or a government loan. For those not eligible, however, our courses are competitively priced and offer good value for money. We also offer instalment plans on some courses.

Course fees

You will find the fee for each course listed alongside the course in this guide or on our website. This fee includes the cost of tuition. For some courses there may be an additional cost for personal materials such as equipment or books.

Free or partially funded courses

You may be eligible for free courses or reduced fees depending on your circumstances, such as:

- You are in receipt of Job Seeker's Allowance or other eligible benefits.
- You earn less than £18,525 per annum (full or part time).
- You are studying for the first time at a particular academic level.
- You are studying for an approved qualification in English and Maths.
- You are studying for an apprenticeship.
- You are studying for an ESOL qualification at college.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Sources of help available to students include the following student loans and support funds.

Advanced Learner Loans

Advanced Learner Loan

A government loan is available for those aged 19 and over (and resident in the UK) to help cover the tuition fees for some Level 3 and 4 qualifications, if you are not eligible for any other funding as below:

- Aged 19–23 and studying your first Level 3 course? If so your course will be free (charges for personal materials or equipment may still apply).
- Aged 19–23 and already have a Level 3? If you wish to study a new course at Level 3 or 4 then you can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to cover the costs.
- Aged 24+? Regardless of whether you already hold a Level 3 or 4 qualification – if you wish to study for a new course at Level 3 or 4 you can apply for the Advanced Learner Loan to cover the tuition fees.

The Advanced Learner Loan will cover all course tuition fees and will be paid directly to the College.

These loans are not means tested or credit checked. You will only start to repay the loan once you finish (or leave) the course and are earning more than £27,295 per year.

Courses qualifying for the loan are marked with an **A** next to the title. Also if you study an Access to HE course your loan could be written off if you successfully progress and complete a degree level course.

Advanced Learner Bursary

If you have a low household income and are studying at Level 3 or above (excluding HND, HNC or Foundation Degree) you may be eligible for help with childcare, travel or equipment costs via the Advanced Learner Bursary.

Tuition fees

You can apply for a Tuition Fee Loan to cover the cost of fees for HNCs, HNDs or Foundation Degrees which are marked with a **D** next to the course. This loan is not based on income and there is no upper age limit for applying. Repayments only start when you finish the course and are earning over £27,295 per year. ENROLMENT INFORMATION

Additional documents required

You will need to provide additional documents when you enrol:

- An official letter on headed paper confirming payment of fees if your employer is paying for your course.
- Your passport, visa or other paperwork relating to your stay in the UK if you have recently arrived in the country or obtained pre-settled or settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme.
- Evidence of receipt of benefits (dated within the last six weeks) if you wish to claim reduced fees. For example, a letter from Jobcentre Plus.
- Your bank details if you wish to pay for your course through an instalment plan.

PLEASE NOTE: you must provide original documents not photocopies.

The easiest and quickest way to enrol is online, where any fees can be paid in full via a credit/ debit card. If needed you can also enrol in person – however you must not come into the College unless you have been asked to do so. Please contact us by email in the first instance.



Paying for your course

Payment for your course needs to be made before your place can be confirmed. You can pay by:

- Credit or debit card (excluding American Express and Solo) by phone or in person at one of our colleges.
- Instalment plan to spread the cost of the eligible course across four payments.

Paying for your course by loan

If you wish to pay for your course using a loan from the Student Loans Company (SLC), you will need to have applied for your loan and had it approved prior to starting your course with us. You will need to provide evidence of your loan application when you enrol.

Payment by an employer

If your employer is paying for your course, you will need to provide an official signed letter of authority from them confirming responsibility for your course fees. If your employer's payment system requires it, you should also provide an official purchase order or project number. Your employer will be invoiced for your course fees after your enrolment. Please ensure you complete your employer's details on your enrolment form. On some courses, employers can access funding to help with the cost of course fees.

Refunds
