Courses

Foundation Year Education Studies w

This **1 year course** requires GCSEs in English and maths at grade 4. We will take into account your subjects studied at Level 3, GCSEs (or equivalent), relevant non-academic achievements outlined in your personal statement, references, and your motivation for study.

Foundation Degree Level 5 Childrens Development & Learning B

This **2 year course** requires an NQF Level 3 qualification, GCSEs in English language and maths at grade 4 and at least 2 years relevant work experience. You must be working at least 2.5 days a week in a relevant setting.

Foundation Degree Level 5 Working with Children & Young People L

This **2 year course** requires a relevant Level 3 qualification and a minimum of 2 years relevant experience. You must be working at least 2 days a week in a relevant setting with someone to act as your mentor and the support of your employer.

Foundation Degree Level 5 Professional Practice in Health & Social Care L

This **2 year course** requires an NQF Level 3 qualification, GCSEs in English language and maths at grade 4 and at least 2 years relevant work experience. You must be working at least 2.5 days a week in a relevant care setting.

BA (Hons) Level 6 Working in Integrated Services for Children & Young People L

This **1 year course** requires a foundation degree in a related subject and a Level 2 qualification in English and maths.

Foundation Degree Level 5 Business Management L

This **2 year course** requires GCSEs in English and maths at grade 4. Applicants without GCSEs but with relevant experience or other qualifications are also encouraged to apply.

BTEC Level 5 Higher National Diploma Business L

This **2 year course** requires a Level 3 qualification in any discipline and GCSEs in English and maths at grade 4.

Higher National Diploma Level 5 Digital Technologies W

This **2 year course** requires either a BTEC Level 3 qualification in computing, business or creative digital media production or a GCE Advanced Level profile with a strong performance in a relevant subject or adequate performance in more than one GCE subject.

Plus GCSEs in English and maths at grade 4 and other related Level 3 qualifications or an Access to Higher Education Diploma.

Level 4 BTEC Foundation Diploma in Art, Design and Media for Stage and Screen W

This **1 year course** requires either two A Levels or a BTEC Level 3 Diploma in a related subject plus a suitable portfolio of work.

Hair & Beauty VTCT Certificate Level 4 in Laser & Intense Pulsed Light (IPL) Treatments L



This 18 week course

requires a Level 3 in Beauty Therapy (Diploma) gualification and GCSEs in English and maths at grade 4. You must be working within a salon, spa or clinic environment with a full uniform (SIMKI scrub top and bottoms).

Level 4 Certificate in Education & Training W

This **34 week course**

requires a Level 3 in the subject you wish to teach and a Level 2 Maths (or be working towards this if maths is not your specialist subject).

No prior teaching experience required but a guaranteed minimum of 30 hours teaching (paid or voluntary) is required over the duration of the course.

Level 4 UAL **Professional Diploma** in Performance W

This **1 year course** requires two A Levels or a BTEC Level 3 Diploma in a related subject plus a successful audition.
