About the Course

Schools Transition Programme

The Schools Transition Programme is specifically aimed at individual learners in school years 10 & 11 who are experiencing difficulties accessing mainstream education or are home educated.

The course provides opportunities to return to learning. The programme, where possible, is tailored to each individual learner, providing a

flexible return to study e.g. a phased introduction to BCA. The programme will include a vocational area of choice with the opportunity to access English, Maths and Science.

If on school roll these can work in partnership with the students' other studies at school for up to a maximum of 3 days a week. If home educated the course is for a maximum of 2 days a week.

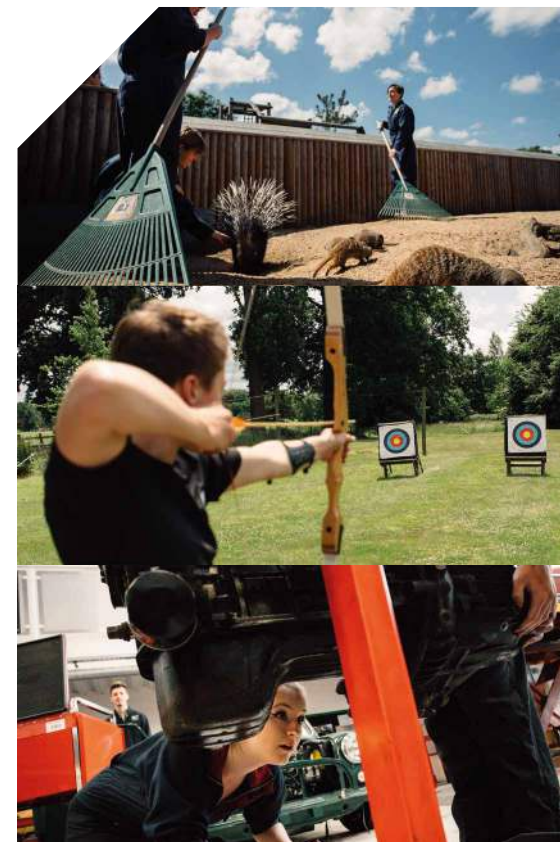
Schools Partnership Courses

BCA can provide schools with the opportunity to partner in specialist 14-16 programmes. We offer students in year 10 and 11 the opportunity to study a college course alongside their existing GCSE subjects at school. A 14-16 programme in partnership with you.

Research also shows that exam success rates improve through vocational learning, as students are happier and more fulfilled when their learning is centred on practical work experience.
